THE COMPETITION

There will be three separate Knockouts

1. 7-Person Team Champions.
2. League Individual Champion.
3. Ladies Individual Champion.

THE GRAND FINALS WILL BE HELD AT VAUXHALL HOLIDAY PARK, GREAT YARMOUTH OVER THE WEEKEND OF 9th, 10th and 11th of NOVEMBER 2012

RULES and REGULATIONS

1. League to register by 29th of June 2012 with payment of £50. Entry open to EPA affiliated leagues only. Payment includes registration for all 3 events. Leagues may also enter their league runners – up or Cup Winners. Payment for second entry is an additional £50. Block entries only will be accepted, there will be no additional singles places available.
2. **VERY IMPORTANT** – This event is for current reigning league champions. If your season is currently in progress and will complete before June 30th, then the current league champions may represent your league, otherwise the previous seasons champions may represent your league. **REMEMBER THE CLOSING DATE IS June 29th 2012**
3. Teams / Players cannot be nominates, they must be league champions.
4. If any League Champion does not wish to represent their league then the runners up will be accepted.
5. The **Individual Champions will be amateur only**. If the Champion is a professional then the highest finishing amateur will qualify.
6. Teams to register 10 players, (maximum of 4 professional / Internationals can register but only 2 can play in a match) **Only players who were registered with the winning team and who also played a minimum of 50% of their teams matches are able to play for the team**. Players can only enter the competition once. Any team playing a player that has played for another team in the event will be expelled from the event.
7. Each category will be run as a separate knockout. If a player is a Champion in more than one category, the player will only be allowed to register for a maximum of two categories, team event plus one other. If the same player is the Champion in the Individual and Ladies, the player can only register for one of these categories, the player must choose which category to enter, the runner up can be entered in the other. If the individual is part of the Championship Team, this is allowed.
8. Players must be 18 years of age by the 29th of June.
9. **Teams and Individuals must have their entries verified by an executive committee member of their league and the County they are affiliated to. Entries must also have copies of their final league tables and singles knockout sheets attached. Failure to supply information will result in your entry being rejected.**
10. Early rounds will be played in your local area to minimise travel as much as possible.
11. All Leagues / Participants will be deemed to have read and agree to abide by these rules and regulations.
12. All events are to be played to World 8 Ball Rules (WEPF) as issued by the EPA.
13. The organisers reserve the right to amend the competition according to circumstances prevailing.

ALL LEAGUES WILL BE REQUIRED TO SEND FINAL LEAGUE TABLES / KNOCKOUT DETAILS IF YOUR LEAGUE IS UNABLE TO SUPPLY DETAILS FOR ANY REASON DO NOT ENTER

Dear Pool Team Organiser,

Welcome to the 2012 Champion of Champions Pool Tournament, which is sponsored by Vauxhall Holiday Park, Great Yarmouth.

The tournament will again have three different events: Mens and Ladies individual events plus the main team event.

PRIZE FUND IS £15,000

With prizes down to the last 16 in all events

Entry to the Champion of Champions is open **only to EPA affiliated leagues**.

All team entries must be submitted from leagues, all entries must be authenticated by a League and a County Committee official. Entries must also be supported by League Tables and Knockout details. Individual entries will only be accepted when supported by a team entry.

Entry fee is £50, this covers a block entry for 1 team, 1 individual and 1 ladies individual entry. Leagues not taking advantage of both singles places will not be offered a reduction of the fee.

A league may enter two entries for each of the three categories providing they are the Champions and Runners-Up (or Cup Winners) Second entry is subject to an additional entry fee of £50.

The event will be played to World Eightball Pool Federation (WEPF) rules.

HOW TO ENTER

To enter this event ensure that all sections of the entry form are completed and signed by your League and County officials, ensure the team manager and players all sign in the allocated places, simply send the form to the address below with the appropriate entry fees. Leagues requiring additional entry forms should contact the tournament organiser by phone, mail or e-mail.
