It is essential that you arrange to play your match as soon as possible. Because of the restrictions on time, if your match is not played by the deadline date, both players will be eliminated from the event.

There will be no extension of deadlines regardless of the reason.

I will only accept results by these two methods, please do not phone or leave a voice message.

The match is to be played to **World 8 Ball Pool Rules**, the first player to win 5 frames will win the match. (Best of 9)

Lag for break on the first frame, determines break order for the whole match, including a deciding frame if required, i.e., win the lag, break on frames 1,3,5,7,9,

Your opponent's details are listed on the information sheet. It is the primary responsibility of the home player to arrange the match. Please do not sit back if you are the away player. You should both make every effort to arrange the match on a mutually agreeable date and time. If your phone number or email is not on the contact list it is probably due to the fact it was not entered on your entry form. If this is the case it is your responsibility to contact your opponent regardless of whether or not you are at home.

I must also remind you that this is an EPA event. Although players are not required to hold an EPA ID card to play in the event. Any player that has had their card removed, or if they play Black Ball above local league level may not take part in this event at any level or at the National Finals
