Tournament Regulations

This is your opportunity to play in the EPA National Under 23 Pool Championships at Vauxhall Holiday Park, Great Yarmouth, to compete for a share in the £500 minimum prize fund. Prize fund will increase with additional entries.

Entry: **Restricted to members of EPA affiliated leagues. No cue-sport professionals.** Closing date for entry is Sunday 17 February. Entry forms to be sent, with a cheque/postal order, made payable to EPA, to the address given. Payments direct to EPA account will no longer be accepted.

Rules: Played to World 8-ball Pool Rules.

Play: Play will commence at 7pm on Wednesday 27 February and conclude on Thursday 28 February.

No denims or trainers please. EPA Dress code will be enforced.

Venue: Vauxhall Holiday Park, Great Yarmouth. Accommodation forms will be forwarded if requested, giving special rates for those who wish to stay over the weekend. Wednesday evening accommodation will be available at no extra cost for entrants who are staying the weekend, subject to availability. Wrist bands must be worn at all times.

Conditions of Entry All players must agree to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the English Pool Association. Players reaching the semi-final stage will be required to attend the presentation ceremony, failure to do so will result in the loss of all prizes.

The Tournament Directors decisions will be final in all cases. This is a limited entry competition and the competition will be closed prior to the closing date if sufficient entries are received.
