Details about road works

Dear Sir/Madam

Work to improve safety along the A47 between Acle and Great Yarmouth

We are working on behalf of Highways England to improve the A47 near you. This work will help to make the road safer between Acle and Great Yarmouth.

Subject to weather conditions, we plan to complete this work **between Monday 20 February and Saturday 4 March, working between 20:00 and 06:00** on weeknights only. We apologise for any delays this may cause you and for any inconvenience caused by the noise while we are working.

To keep road users at a safe distance from the works, we will close the A47 between the A1064 Acle Roundabout and the A12/A149 Vauxhall Roundabout. There will be a clearly signed diversion route in place, whereby drivers heading eastbound on the A47 will be directed to:

- Exit the A47 at the Acle Roundabout, then;
- Take the A1064 north-east towards Caister-on-Sea, then;
- Take the A149 south towards Great Yarmouth, then;
- Take the A149 Acle New Road to join the A12 at Vauxhall Roundabout.

Drivers heading northbound on the A12 will be directed to follow this diversion in reverse.

While the road is closed you will still be able to access and exit Vauxhall Holiday Park. Please have a copy of this letter to hand at all times.

- To access the park, slowly approach the operative at the edge of the Vauxhall Roundabout closure, explain your destination and **show them this letter**. If we are working elsewhere you will be allowed to proceed without an escort.
- To exit the park, slowly approach the operative by the entrance to Vauxhall Holiday Park and explain that you would like to leave. If we are working elsewhere you will be allowed to proceed without an escort.
- If we are working between the park and Vauxhall Roundabout you will be escorted through the closure. Please drive slowly and carefully, obeying the operative's instructions at all times.

We will do our utmost to complete the works as quickly as possible, avoiding disturbance and keeping noise to a minimum.
